The delivery of a coastal exemplar chalet accommodation project is included in Council's Economic Action Plan and Asset Management Framework.

ELDC require the services of a Civil Engineer and a Quantity Surveyor to provide an initial view on project constraints and costings. Gleeds will manage the process and provide a high level cost plan. AECOM services will comprise the identification and assessment of the suitability of low and zero carbon (LZC) technology options for the proposed eco-chalets on the Skegness Foreshore. This assessment will provide recommendations for low carbon energy supply solutions to support the project team in decision making at an early stage of design. The assessment will also include a brief review of ground conditions and appraisal of flood risk and the identification of appropriate mitigation measures.

It is proposed that Perfect Circle are appointed by the Council, under the national Built Environment Consultancy Services (BECS) Framework, via the Scape Procure Group. Scape Procure have designed frameworks to deliver outcomes that are economically advantageous and quality assured. They also remove the need for clients to carry out their own OJEU procurement.

The framework is therefore intended to deliver the fastest route to the appointment of a qualified supplier, rather than pursuing other procurement options.
