- 9. The reason for the decision and other alternative options considered and rejected:

The Council has identified a need for an additional two pool cars to be purchased for staff use in the pool car fleet and has identified that the VW Polo models currently operated represent the most suitable and practicable vehicle choice.

As there is currently a minimum 26 week lead time for delivery of the desired models when purchasing under the Crown Procurement Service, purchasing 2 preregistered vehicles directly from a VW main dealer is the preferred option.

Decision Notice Form (ExD2)

In addition to being immediately available for delivery these preregistered vehicles offer a cheaper option than ordering the equivalent models through the Crown Procurement Service.

Purchasing these vehicles direct from the main dealer, requires an exemption to the Council's Contract Procedures under Rule 3.1.2. (9), that The Chief Executive, S151 Officer and Leader of the Council believe a contract to represent Value for Money for the taxpayer and the evidence of this is sufficient to withstand scrutiny.
