Children's Services work proactively with families who may be waiting for a DFG. Often, children's DFGs are complicated and can take longer to implement than adult DFG' leading to a need to provide interim, temporary solutions to lighten the burden on the family (for example, equipment such

as stair climbers, modular ramps and bath tables). The budget provision for such equipment (LCC) has been subject to a lot of demand and during 2018, funding was exhausted in a matter of months.

To avoid the risk of families being left at risk whilst waiting for a DFG, it is recomneded that a central / pooled fund is created to children's OT's to be able to use this funding to buy further equipment that is needed whilst a family is waiting for a DFG; on the basis that:

- o The fund is pooled and managed centrally / administered by LCC
- The equipment purchased through the pooled fund is allocated to a central store and reallocated as required

It is recommended that this is a non-recurrent contribution.
