East Lindsey District Council has a new corporate priority around the natural environment and this project helps to support that strategic aim. Town and parish councils were invited to register an interest in the establishment of a new community orchard in their area. Following site visits, it has been possible to identify 10 potential sites across the District. Community orchards can provide multiple benefits. Not only contributing to tree planting targets and supporting carbon storage, they also enhance biodiversity, encourage community engagement and have the potential to

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enhance health and wellbeing of residents through interaction with the natural environment. This project will also include a training element to give local communities the skills to undertake the required management of their orchards. A budget underspend has been identified to support the project. The total cost of this project is £4,388 + VAT (where applicable) however actual costs are expected to be lower due to identified match funding opportunities.
