- 9. The reason for the decision and other alternative options considered and rejected:

The Department of Works and Pensions COVID Local Support Grant (CLSG) funding has been made available to Lincolnshire County Council (LCC) to cover the period 17 April 2021 until 20 June 2021 to support those most in need. The aim is to give vulnerable households peace of mind as COVID restrictions are eased by helping those who need it to have food on the table and other essentials.

LCC were provided with total grant of £523,165 under section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, to administer the scheme and provide assistance to vulnerable families with children and other vulnerable households, particularly affected by the pandemic. With this funding, the county council made a payment to educational settings to support families during May half terms and enable them to access food. This left an expect sum of £110,933 which was equally divided and distributed to

District Councils for local use to support individuals and families with cost for food, utilities, and other essentials including white goods.

On 17 May 2021, each District area was allocated £15,848 for local use. ELDC will be working with trusted Third Party Organisations (community larders, food banks, uniform banks) to distribute this funding as they have the local knowledge and are best placed to identify and help children, families and individuals in most in need in their community. Targeting this money effectively will ease the burden faced by vulnerable households across the District worrying about paying the next utility bill or food shop due to the pandemic.
