Victim Lincs social media saw good reach throughout December with particularly high reach and interactions on the introductory post for the new Sexual Violence Co-Ordinator role.

Coverage of the Victim Lincs team attending events such as the LincoInshire Business Domestic Abuse Conference event continues to receive good engagement.
