 - In July 2021, ELDC decision on revised customer access arrangements included a proposal to develop, co-ordinate and deliver a customer hub model with community partners across the District. Feedback from established community drop-ins and partners highlighted a need to support exisiting hubs with funding as contribution to help them to help residents navigate and access services and support.
 - During 2022/23 small one off grants of up to £2000 were offered community support hubs (hosted by charities and faith groups).
 This has supported hubs with increased overheads, upgrading qi-fi and equpitment and expaninding ther drop-ins.
 - One off grants for financial year 2023/24 will be offered to support continual development of local network of hubs to recognise the valuable contribution of local third sector partners and ELDC's role in community leadership.
