Topic: Partnership Enviro-Crime Enforcement Contract

Objectives and Key Issues:

In early 2022, a Partnership enviro-crime enforcement contract was signed off and mobilised for the sub region. The contract includes foot patrols and overt surveillance capability for the purpose of detecting environmental offences and taking enforcement action where appropriate against such offences such as littering, dog fouling and fly-tipping.

The contract extended existing provision in Boston whilst bringing in completely new capability and capacity to East Lindsey and South Holland. Contractor performance is managed in each locality by Enviro - crime Liaison Officers and key performance indicators are reported to members through the partnership performance management framework.

An early review of the contractual arrangement together with performance and the benefits being delivered/achieved for the Partnership would be helpful.
