The Chairman of the Overview Committee has been notified by the Proper Officer of the intention to make the aforementioned Key Decision in accordance with Regulation 10. Regulation 9 of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 provides that where the Executive Board propose to make a key decision, that decision must not be made until at least 28 clear days public notice has been given. Where it is not possible to give 28 clear days' notice, Regulation 10 of the above Regulations require that the Council must make available at its offices, and publish on its website, a notice setting out the reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable

Reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable -

The report was not included in the forward plan due to the timescales required for the contract negotiation, and the subsequent requirement for a decision to be made on the future of the management of the public conveniences to ensure the ability to deliver the service from April 2023 is not compromised.

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to information) Regulations 2012 -

If part of an Executive meeting is to be considered in private session, then at least 28 clear days' notice is required to be given. The Chairman of Overview Committee has agreed that the item may be considered in private if required being urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.
