Scrutiny Topic	Partnership Enviro Crime Enforcement Contract
(Name of review)	
Rationale (Purpose and objectives of the scrutiny review)	In February 2022, an Enviro-Crime Enforcement contract for the Partnership was agreed. The contract included provision of foot patrols to proactively detect envirocrimes and take appropriate action and camera surveillance of fly tipping hotspots. Boston had legacy contract arrangements with Kingdom which East Lindsey adopted mid 2021 until the permanent contract arrangement with Kingdom came into being. South Holland had no prior external contract arrangement. The Partnership enviro-crime contract expires on the 28/02/2026. There is a clause in the contract stating that at the Councils discretion an extension of a further 2 years can be applied/negotiated.
	As we are at the mid-point of the contract, there is a need to review the operation and to look at performance and the benefits being delivered/achieved.
