(Focus of the review)	 Review the current cark park finances – both in terms of monies received and a breakdown of where that money is spent; Consideration of visitor numbers and parking habits such as length of stay; Consideration of variations in policy in different areas / car park according to need Review of parking permits and how they are used / promoted to residents / workers / visitors. Consideration of other parking options across the district, managed by other organisations, noting that on-street residents parking schemes are the responsibility of Lincolnshire County Council.
