

Scrutiny Topic	To review the running of Invest East Lindsey Limited, with a particular focus on Kingfisher Caravan Bark
(Name of review) Rationale	Kingfisher Caravan Park.
(Purpose and objectives of the scrutiny review)	In December 2019, Invest East Lindsey was formed with an objective to: operate a caravan sales and lettings business at Kingfisher Caravan Park in Ingoldmells, Skegness; develop and operate a lettings business for a number of eco-lodges within the Council's administrative area; undertake a mixed portfolio of development to address unmet housing need in the Council's administrative area; and deliver a financial return for the benefit of the Council.
	Three years in, it is an opportune time to look at the work done so far and plans for the future to check where the company is, where it wants to be and if it has the resourcing and plans in place to get to where it wants to be. Objectives include:
	<ul> <li>are there gaps in Board expertise?</li> <li>how are projects assessed for risk and value for money?</li> <li>how can the Audit &amp; Governance and Overview Committees play their part in oversight of the Company?</li> <li>Look at how other councils go about such initiatives and learn why some succeed whilst others fail and have to be wound up.</li> </ul>
	A key part of this scrutiny work will be looking at the performance of Kingfisher Caravan Park and the current and future plans for taking it forward.
