To make a further £31,750 **advance** to the London Road Sports Partnership of the £95,000 grant approved in principle by the Executive at its meeting on 8 May 2024. The advance is to be fully recoverable from the Partnership in the event its current tenancy of the land and buildings known as the London Road Sports Pavilion and associated recreation grounds, Louth, outlined red on the plan attached to this decision is not superseded by a lease. The advance is additional to the £30,000 forwarded pursuant to a decision on 23 May 2024.

The decision to advance the money is necessary to support the viability of the Partnership's operation of the London Road Sports Pavilion. The money of offered as an advance to the grant on the basis that the formal lease required to trigger the grant was not complete at the date of this decision.
