PUBLIC NOTICE**

The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

Notice is hereby given under Regulation 10 of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the Leader of the Council, on the 3rd of December 2024, will be requested to take a Key Decision to accept up to £3m external funding to prepare the Coastal Strategy by working with Environment Agency and Lincolnshire County Council.

The Chairman of the Overview Committee has been notified by the Proper Officer of the intention to make the aforementioned Key Decision in accordance with Regulation 10. Regulation 9 of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 provides that where the Leader of the Council propose to make a key decision, that decision must not be made until at least 28 clear days public notice has been given. Where it is not possible to give 28 clear days' notice, Regulation 10 of the above Regulations require that the Council must make available at its offices, and publish on its website, a notice setting out the reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable.

Reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable -

The report was not included in the forward plan as an Executive Board key decision. A timely decision is required to enable a recommendation to the Full Council regarding this funding due to the constraints of timescales for funding body and to enable the partners in continuing their work on the coastal strategy.
