Urgent Decision: **YES** : This decision is considered to be urgent as officers need to be in a position to enter into contractual arrangements by no later than 31st January to allow works in site to commence in week commencing 3rd February 2025 to allow the project to be delivered in time for opening in late May 2025.

The decision is urgent as any delay caused by the call-in process would seriously prejudice the Council's or the public's interests. In accordance with the Council's Constitution the Chairman of the Council has agreed that the decision proposed is a reasonable in the circumstances and to it being treated as a matter of urgency.

DECISION:

That Cllr Leyland approves a decision to allocate a further £124K capital funding to the existing £400K to allow officers to enter contracts for the planned refurbishment works to the historic paddling pool to allow works to be completed in May 2025

Reason for the Decision:

To allow officers to formally enter fully funded contracts for the planned refurbishment works to the historic paddling pool to allow works to be completed by May 2025.

Alternative options considered:

Not to approve additional funding. If sufficient additional funding is not allocated as per the recommendation contained in the associated report, officers will be unable to enter relevant contractual arrangements for the required works to be completed.
